## Gateball Singles Event 2012

### Event Conditions of Entry

- Eligibility:** Players must be affiliated with their State Croquet Association; proof of current registration required and be capable to perform Referee and Record duties for a Gateball Game.
- Equipment:** Gateball courts will be prepared with gates, goal pole, balls and scoreboards. Players shall provide their own sticks.
- Rules:** Matches will be played under the Rules of Gateball as stated in the 'Official Gateball Rules Guide for Referees 2011' published by the World Gateball Union as well as Gateball Australia, Gateball Information Pamphlet Number 4, Gateball Singles Rules.
- Referees:** All matches will be conducted with a Referee. Players on duty (Referee and Recorder) for Block A matches must be from Block B; and vice versa.
- Referees must be in position near the ball before calling the number to play.
- Recorder/Assistant Referee must be at the boundary observing play and confirming gates scored with the referee.
- Match Format:** Matches will be played in a round-robin or 'block draw', if block draw, top two players of each block to play off. Final details will be available when the number of entries is known. The Event Manager will decide the final format.
- The games will be time controlled by the Management, a bell will ring to give five minutes warning, and then all games will start together on the second bell. If the referee has to pause a game, then that game will go by the Referee's wrist scorer/timer.
- Any matters arising concerning the Event will be resolved at the discretion of the Event Manager and/or Event Referee and their decision will be final.
- Dress Code:** Players must wear enclosed athletic shoes and not have anything on their person that might impede the game.
- Inclement Weather:** The Event Manager and/or Event Referee reserves the right to change the format of play and make such other changes as may be necessary in the event of inclement weather.
